### Pneumococcal Vaccine

This year we will be offering a pneumococcal vaccine to all our patients aged 75 years and over. This is a single injection given subcutaneously or intramuscularly into the arm and can be given at the same time as the influenza vaccine.

Invasive pneumococcal disease (pneumonia) is a major cause of morbidity and mortality, especially among the very young and elderly population.
